Fedwire Instructions

Fedwire is a high speed, real time electronic funds transfer system operated by Federal Reserve Banks. It is the primary U.S. network for large-value or time-critical payments.

- Transaction limit is \$9,999,999,999.99
- Fedwires are settled the same day and can be viewed in the Collections Information Repository (CIR) in near real-time.
- Fedwires are considered irrevocable and can only be returned per agency approval
- Fedwire is a free service to federal agencies. The Fiscal Service charges no fees for receipt or processing of agency Fedwires.
- Fedwires are expensive to customers as their banks typically charge large fees.

When should you use Fedwire?

- Large dollar payments (*generally greater than \$100k*).
- Small volume of transactions
- Time critical payments
