Re: Amendment for OpenElect 1.3 Test Report and Scope of Certification

It was determined that the Scope of Certification document did not correctly reflect the system as tested.

In the **Components Included** section of the Scope of Certification:

In **System Components** section of table:

Component EOS Operating System should be Linux CentOS version 5.7 and 6.5.

In COTS Components section of table:

- CentOS Linux should be versions 5.0, 5.7, 6.3, 6.5
- MySQL Database should be versions 5.0.45-7, 5.1.71-1
 - Note: 5.0.45-7 is used in CentOS 5.7 and 5.1.71-1 is used in CentOS 6.5

This change is the result of adjustments requested to the NTS Test Report to accurately represent the tested system. Specifically in **Table 2-9 Unisyn OVS 1.3 COTS Operating System Software Descriptions.**

In row two (Linux CentOS Distribution used for OCS and OVCS) – Filename column and Hash Value (MD5) column should be changed to reflect the 5.7 version. Software version is correct.

An additional row should be added for the EOS (OCS and OVCS) that indicates the newer CentOS version.
