

Report on Expenditure of Title II, Section 251 Funds
October 2004 through September 2005**

As requested by the U.S. Election Assistance Commission, the following narrative report outlines expenditures and related activities conducted by the State of Arkansas during Federal fiscal year 2005 utilizing Title II, Section 251 funds.

During the 2005 Federal fiscal year, the State of Arkansas spent \$1,512,809.99 in Title II funds to provide local election official training, to comply with the provisions of Title III of the Help America Vote Act by completing the installation of a statewide voter registration system and to begin project planning for installation of a HAVA compliant statewide voting system.

Statewide Voter Registration List--\$1,482,885

Title II funds were used to continue the implementation of a statewide voter registration system pursuant to the requirements in Title III, Section 303 of the Help America Vote Act. Arkansas's Network of Voters in Arkansas (NOVA) is a uniform, centralized, interactive computerized statewide voter registration list administered by the Secretary of State and accessible in a real-time format by each of Arkansas's 75 county clerks.

The Secretary of State utilized state funds and Section 101 monies to establish a secure high-speed Internet network connection for each county courthouse in Arkansas as the foundation for NOVA. Working with an information systems consultant, the Arkansas SOS reviewed voter registration and election management systems proposals, appointed various evaluation teams made up of state and local election officials and other state agency representatives to review and comment on proposals submitted. After a lengthy evaluation process, the State entered into a contract for the NOVA system in February 2005. As noted in the narrative report concerning expenditures for Title I funds, project planning, hardware procurement and data conversion began upon contract execution and was initially funded with budgeted Section 101 funds as outlined in the Arkansas State Plan.

The State spent Title II funds for system design, data conversion and testing, user acceptance testing, state agency data sharing and training for local election officials on use of the new system. Additional hardware purchases included servers for the two state data centers and peripherals such as printers and scanners to be installed in each county clerk's office. Nearly 2/3 of Arkansas's counties were live on the system by September 30, 2005. The remaining data conversion, training and testing costs will be covered in the next Title II report.

Voting Systems--\$29,925²

² Expenditures noted include program management and consulting fees associated with planning and installation of a statewide voting system. For reference purposes, those Title II funds are classified under the "Other Activities" portion of the Title II budget outlined in the State Plan.

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The State of Arkansas did not expend Title II funds for the purchase of voting equipment during the current reporting period. However, the Arkansas SOS did engage the services of an information systems consultant in developing the requirements for a Request for Proposals for HAVA compliant voting systems, analyzing proposals submitted, and constructing a methodology for evaluating proposals. The Arkansas Voting System RFP was issued in July 2005, and review and evaluation of proposals continued until the end of the reporting period.
