Report on HAVA Title I, Section 101 Funds
Reporting Period January 1, 2006 through December 31, 2006

The State of Colorado received \$4,860,301 in Section 101 Funds in 2003. Through December 2006, interest earned on those funds totaled \$523,261, of which \$158,049 was earned during the calendar year 2006.

For the period January 1, 2006 through December 31, 2006, the Department expended **\$182,407** of federal HAVA funds toward the following activities under Section 101:

Administrative costs associated with overseeing the state's HAVA program, managing the HAVA funds, implementing the State Plan, and carrying out the requirements of Title III. Expenditures included administrative personnel costs of \$102,099 and general operating expenses (leased space, travel, supplies, postage, etc.) of \$80,308 for the HAVA unit of the department. The Department also expended \$53,150 in State cash funds towards these administrative costs.

During this reporting period, the Department received a refund from a contractor who was developing a statewide voter registration system. The State terminated the contract and \$2,000,000 was refunded to the state. Part of the refund was applied to prior years' expenses incurred by the State with Section 101 funds; the remainder was applied to expenses paid to the contractor under Title II funds. (These are reported on the respective SF269's.) Therefore, the federal share of the net outlays under Section 101 for this reporting period shows an increase in the Section 101 fund balance over the previous reporting period.

The unobligated balance of Section 101 funds as of December 31, 2006 is \$3,717,849.
