

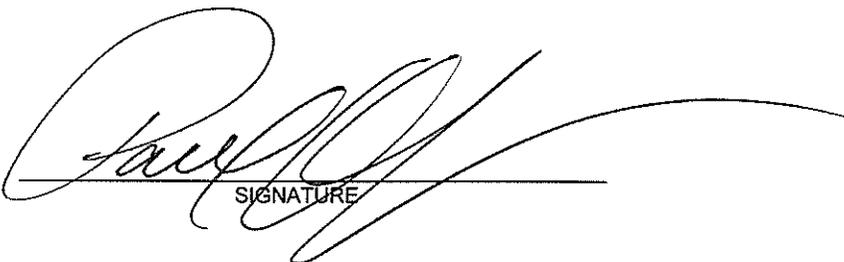

Section 102 Funds Help America Vote Act – Narrative
State of Indiana
January 1, 2005 – December 31, 2005

All HAVA Section 102 funds received by the State of Indiana were sent to counties with qualifying precincts in the form of a reimbursement. These funds were used to partially purchase new voting systems in those counties to replace punch card or lever machine voting systems. Counties were reimbursed at a level of \$3,192 per qualifying precinct for the purchase of either Direct Record Electronic or Optical Scan voting systems.
