

The above expenditures are solely related to the purchase and implementation of the Diebold Election Systems Accuvote-TS and AccuVote-OS voting system as the new Statewide voting system in Maryland. The State Plan earmarks \$30 million of the HAVA federal funds for purchase of and expenses related to a new Statewide voting system. Maryland has purchased 16,007 voting machines for 23 of 24 counties; the 24th county will implement the new voting machines in 2005. However, the line items designating payments to the Treasurer for the voting machines are the 2004 payments for the loan to purchase the equipment and are not reflective of the total costs of the machines.
