REPORT ON EXPENDITURE OF TITLE I, SEC. 102 FUNDS DURING CY 2005**

Title I, Sec. 102

Punch Card Buyout - \$2,736,335

In its state plan, Missouri expressed its intent to participate in the punch card replacement program. At that time, 43 jurisdictions were determined to be eligible for the program. Missouri applied for and received the deadline waiver under Section 102(a)(3)(B). (*State Plan, page 38*)

During Calendar Year 2005, twenty-seven jurisdictions received funding during the reporting period to replace their punch card systems for a total of \$2,736,335, of which \$86,792 was interest earned. At the time each jurisdiction applied for its reimbursement, interest earned to date was calculated and added to the grant amount it received.

In each case, the jurisdictions chose to purchase optical scan-based voting systems to replace punch card voting systems. Each jurisdiction was responsible for selecting the type, make, or model of system to purchase. The systems purchased were qualified for use in Missouri by the Secretary of State's Office as required by state law.

Interest Earned - \$269,345

The Missouri Secretary of State invested Title I, Sec. 102 funds during the reporting period and accrued interest in the amount of \$269,345.

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
