Dear Election Assistance Commission:

Pursuant to 42 USC § 15408, North Carolina submits the Federal FY05 (October 1, 2005-September 30, 2006) report concerning HAVA Title III activities during that time.

Enclosed is the FY05 Form 269 report of Title II requirement funds activity. Also enclosed are additional detail reports that might be helpful.

FY05 expenditures of Title II requirement funds were as follows:

\$39,460,007.60 was spent on Aid and Equipment.

\$40,900.50 was spent on Audit Fees on HAVA funds.

\$8,698.14 was spent on Workshop/Conference Expenses that relate to HAVA.

\$3,043.84 was spent on HAVA related Postage, Freight, and Delivery.

\$259.50 was spent on HAVA related General Office Supplies.

Voting Equipment and related expenditures made up all the \$39,460,007.60 spent on Aid and Equipment. A total of 2576 Model 100 optical scan tabulators, 6253 iVotronic DRE's, and 1899 AutoMarks were purchased for use by our 100 counties. Besides the voting systems themselves, supporting equipment, supplies and software for the systems were purchased, training and support was purchased, and maintenance plans were also among the items purchased. These voting system expenditures have just recently been audited by the North Carolina State Auditor in their annual single audit and they found no issues to report as to the funds spent and the accounting of them. The costs of this extensive audit were \$40,900.50 as noted above.

The analysis and description of the activities funded, as required by Section 258(3) of HAVA are as follows:

Aid and Equipment

In August of 2005, S.L. 2005-323 was passed that decertified all previous voting systems in North Carolina, and required new voting systems that would meet the HAVA and EAC mandates. The RFP produced under the requirement of S.L. 2005-323 resulted in one approved vendor, ES&S, who was approved to sell their M-100 optical scan voting system, their iVotronic Direct Record Electronic touch screen voting system, and their AutoMark ballot marking system in early 2006.

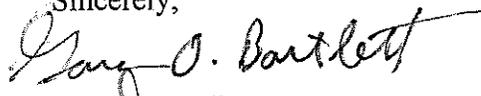
After approval of the voting systems by our agency, the various counties chose which of these systems they wanted to use. Based upon their selections, the machines were centrally ordered, received, and tested by the State Board of Elections, and then shipped to the counties. The counties received installation help and training from both the vendor and this agency. Fully HAVA compliant voting systems were used by all North Carolina counties in the May 2006 Primary, except for two non-covered counties (Buncombe and McDowell). They used a hand count in the May Primary, but later this summer obtained the voting systems and used them in the November 2006 General Election. Since May 2006 the voting systems have worked well and we have had no race or language based complaints about the new voting equipment.

Purchased Services and Supplies

These expenses are set out in the enclosed detail and are self-explanatory.
