**RE: Section 251 Financial Report and Narrative for Federal Fiscal Year 2006**

Dear Election Assistance Commission:

Enclosed is the financial report detailing how Tennessee spent monies allocated under Title II, Section 251 of the Help America Vote Act for the time period between October 1, 2005 and September 30, 2006.

Below is a detailed list of expenditures made by Tennessee with the funds provided under Title II, Section 251 between the months of October 1, 2005 and September 30, 2006.

**1. Title III, Section 301(a) (1), (2) and (3): Voting Systems Standards**

Tennessee purchased five thousand nine hundred and forty four (5,944) new voting machines which totaled \$18,531,415.23. Section 301 mandates that all voting systems meet certain requirements. These machines were purchased in order to comply with Section 301 of the Act.

Attached is a detailed summary of the number and type of voting machines purchased for each county. Additionally, one county was reimbursed a percentage of the cost of machines purchased after the 2000 election and before the passage of the HAVA.

This money was spent to comply with Tennessee's State Plans in the following manner. Tennessee had to purchase a DRE machine for each precinct that would allow individuals with disabilities to vote independently. Approximately

forty-three (43) counties had to replace their punchcard and lever systems with voting systems that complied with Section 301 of the Act. Requirements payments had to be used once the Title I, Section 102 money was spent on this activity. There were also one hundred and eighty-eight (188) precincts that needed to upgrade their central base optical scan systems to precinct base optical scan systems. These purchases brought Tennessee into compliance with Section 301 of the Act.

## 2. Title III, Section 302 (a): Provisional Voting

Tennessee spent \$5,330.00 on provisional ballot bags. Ballot bags are used to retain and transport the provisional ballots during the voting period.

Section 302 of the Act mandated that provisional voting be implemented in the State and Tennessee implemented such a law on July 1, 2003.


