To Whom It May Concern:

The purpose of this letter is to report on the Texas HAVA Title II, section 251 financial activity for the time period covering October 1, 2003 thru September 30, 2004 as required by the U.S. Election Assistance Commission. Specifically, this report will include a list of expenditures made with respect to each category of activities described for the use of funds in HAVA section 251; the number and type of articles of voting equipment obtained with the funds; and an analysis and description of the activities funded to meet HAVA requirements and how such activities conform to the submitted state plan. The federal 269 report for section 251 for the same report period is attached as well.

Texas did not expend Title II, section 251 funds during federal fiscal year 2004. However, a great deal of time was spent during FY 2004 setting a foundation to ensure Texas complies with the mandates of HAVA and expends the funds within the parameters set forth in the various grant regulations governing the funding. The following is a description of those accomplishments:

- Ample time and effort was expended educating Texas counties on the mandates of HAVA and how to properly manage grant funds.
- A grant management system, which includes an online component for counties to apply for funds as well as request reimbursements, was developed.
- Award agreements were issued to all 254 Texas counties, which included terms and conditions for Title II, section 251 funds to acquire an accessible voting system (DRE) in each polling place, purchase equipment or software consistent with section 301 of HAVA, and educate voters and election workers on the Title III requirements of HAVA.
- Texas went through a lengthy procurement process to secure a vendor to develop a HAVA-compliant statewide voter registration system.

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We feel the efforts exerted in 2004 will promote efficiency and accountability as we continue to implement our state plan. If you have additional questions, please do not hesitate to contact my office.
