NARRATIVE REPORT
JANUARY 1, 2005 – DECEMBER 31, 2005**

This narrative report details a description of activities based on the HAVA State Plan for the Territory of the United States Virgin Islands:

COMPLYING WITH REQUIREMENTS OF TITLE 111 – \$137,944

Payments made applicable to this section met the requirements of Title III, particularly for progress to our Computerized Statewide Voter Registration System. Funds were also utilized to upgrade and make available, in all districts, photo equipment and supplies for complying with voter identification and verification at the polls. Payments were made for addressing provisional voting web site access and provisional ballot preparation.

The Statewide Computerized Voter Registration List is described in the HAVA State Plan on pages 22-31.

ELECTION ADMINISTRATION - \$154,407

To advance the implementation of HAVA and the overall administration of elections, we continue to employ two individuals and reimburse our general fund for time spent by management staff in complying with HAVA. Funds were also utilized to supply and equip staff with an environment that best supports them in executing proper procedures and voter registration processes. Staff received training, to include attendance at Election Center activities in order to keep abreast with trends in elections and best practices for election officials. Staff time was also expended in developing good public policy to assist in promoting proper use of election data which should increase participation in the election process.

These activities are described in the V.I. State Plan on page 43.

VOTER EDUCATION - \$74,051

Expenditures in this category mainly supported our Voter Information, Education and Outreach Program. In complying with the voter education segment of this program, we accomplished work in developing sets of Rules and Regulations governing Write-In candidates, Absentee voting procedures, Provisional Voting Procedures and Governance Policy for improved efficiency of our Boards. Through contractual services we have completed the production of radio and television voter education spots. We have begun efforts to partner with civic and community organizations to promote voter participation. Survey tools, to reach the disabled community, have been developed to better determine how to respond to their needs in bringing them closer to the process. As part of our work

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on this component, public machine demonstrations are scheduled for next year and will occur at major sites and activities where all groups of our community gather.

Voter Education is described in the V.I. State Plan on pages 15-18.

INTEREST ACCRUED - \$22,204
