

Two Primary Considerations

- 1. Translation (direct cost)
- 2. Space (indirect costs)







SHARE RESOURCES!


No need to start from scratch when other elections offices already have translated materials.







- 1. Start with a Style Sheet and Glossary to build consistency across products.
- 2. Ask about lower cost for proofing or translating frequently used words.
- 3. Remember that bilingual staff members may not have the writing skills needed for professional translation.



English - Spanish



Adding a second language will make your ballot twice as long.

That affects:

- paper cost
- postage cost
- printing costs
 (toner, maintenance)
- warehouse storage space
- scanning at polling places
- mail ballot processing
- recounts



Space about





- 1. Adding languages to legal notices requires buying additional publication space.
- Creating voter information and marketing materials in multiple languages affects design, printing cost, and space needed to display materials.



- 1. All direct mail to voters
- 2. Notices to voters that are publically posted or published (candidate withdrawal, potentially ineligible voters, public meeting notices, etc.)
- 3. Ballots and sample ballots
- 4. Vote By Mail envelopes and instructional materials
- 5. ADA-compliant ballot marking devices (audio)
- 6. Voter oath, provisional ballot envelopes, other forms in polling places
- 7. Signs in polling places
- 8. Informational displays in the community
- 9. Email newsletters
- 10. Staff in offices and polling places
- 11. Website
- 12. Media outreach


