Constitutional Amendment
Proposed Amendment to Section 9 of
Article 1 (Bail)
Explanation of Propsoed Amendment

The proposed amendment deals with the category of persons who may be denied bail under the State Constitution. The present constitutional provision permits denial of bail only for persons charged with offenses punisheable by death or life of imprisonment, and only where the proof is evident or the presumption is great that the person charged committed the crime. If the people of the State adopt this proposed amendment, judges would also be empowered to deny bail to persons charged with felonies that carry a mandatory sentence of life imprisonment upon conviction where: (1) the proof is evident or the presumption great that the person committed the crime; and (2) the count, after a hearing, finds that the defendant poses a real and present threat to the safety

Further, the amendment would require the State to reimburse a unit of local government for costs incurred as a result of this provision.
