Dear Mr. Hancock:

Election Systems & Software, LLC ("ES&S") respectfully requests that the EAC accept this notice as ES&S' formal request to withdraw Unity 3.2.0.0 from the current list of EAC certified systems, effective as of August 15, 2012.

As you know, ES&S' newest version of EAC approved software, Unity 3.2.0.0 Rev 3, has now effectively resolved all of the issues identified in the EAC's *Formal Investigation Report for Election Systems and Software Unity 3.2.0.0*, dated December 20, 2011.

Since the time of the EAC approval of Unity 3.2.0.0 Rev 3, ES&S has worked with the existing users of 3.2.0.0 to ensure that they have the updated certified version of software available to them at no charge.

It is our understanding that upon approval of this request the EAC will place 3.2.0.0 on a list of previously certified systems and it will no longer remain an active certification. We would appreciate your confirmation of that understanding.
