This document summarizes the changes made to the Election Administration and Voting Survey (EAVS) between 2012 and 2014

**Global Changes**

- Changed all instances of "2012" to "2014"

**Page 1**

- In the third paragraph from the top, changed "~~this~~ data" to "**these** data"

**Section A**

- In the gray instructions box for this section, changed "~~removal~~ notices" to "**confirmation** notices" in the description of Question A10
- Question A4 - changed " such as Connecticut and Rhode Island" to "such as Alaska and Rhode Island" at end of question
- Questions A6, A7, A8, and A9 from "~~N/A~~" to "**Data not available**" at the top of each column in the response grid
- Question A10 - Changed the wording of the question from :

**A10. Enter the total number of confirmation notices sent to voters in the period between the close of registration for the November 2012 general election and the close of registration for the November 2014 general election, because ~~the person had not voted or appeared to vote in the two previous federal elections (per NVRA Section 8 (d) (2))~~.**

To:

**A10. Enter the total number of confirmation notices sent to voters in the period between the close of registration for the November 2012 general election and the close of registration for the November 2014 general election because either 1) there is an indication that the registrant no longer resides in the registrar's jurisdiction, or 2) the voter has not voted or appeared to vote in a Federal election during the period.**

## Section B

- Top of gray instruction box for Section B: Changed text from:

~~Section B serves as the EAC's standardized format~~ for the state reporting of UOCAVA voting information as required by 42 U.S.C. §1973ff-1. States that complete and timely submit this section to the EAC will fulfill their UOCAVA reporting requirement under 42 U.S.C §1973ff-1(c).

To:

**For 2014, Section B includes the FVAP Post-Election Voting Survey of Local Election Officials. EAC incorporated these questions** for the States' reporting of UOCAVA voting information as required by 42 U.S.C. §1973ff-1. States that complete and timely submit this section to the EAC will fulfill their UOCAVA reporting requirement under 42 U.S.C §1973ff-1(c).

- Bottom of gray instruction box for Section B - Added descriptions for additional questions from the Federal Voting Assistance Program (FVAP), Questions B19 through B35.
- Questions B4, B5, B6, and B7 from "~~N/A~~" to "**Data not available**" at the top of each column in the response grid
- Questions B9, B10, B11, and B12 from "~~N/A~~" to "**Data not available**" at the top of each column in the response grid
- Questions B15, B16, B17, and B18 from "~~N/A~~" to "**Data not available**" at the top of each column in the response grid
- Questions B19 through B35 were added for the 2014 survey. The data for these questions was formerly collected in a separate survey conducted by FVAP.

## Section F

- Changed wording of Question F3 from:

**F3. HAVA 303(b) states that all first-time voters in a State who registered ~~to vote~~ by mail are required to provide identification in order to vote and have their ballot counted. Enter the number of first-time voters who provided identification and ~~were able to vote in~~ the November 2014 general election in your jurisdiction.**

To:

**F3. HAVA 303(b) states that all first-time voters in a State who registered by mail are required to provide identification in order to vote and have their ballot counted. Enter the number of first-time voters who provided identification and **had their ballot counted for** the November 2014 general election in your jurisdiction.**
