Overview

- EAC received approximately 2,800 comments from a wide variety of stakeholders
- Principle 13 – Data Protection (ban wireless); require hand-marked paper ballots: ~93%
- Other comments: ~7%

- February 28, 2019 – Comment period started
- June 7, 2019 – Comment period ended
- June 21, 2019 – EAC and NIST met to review and discuss comments
- July 17, 2019 – EAC and NIST met to review and discuss comments
- July 30, 2019 – EAC and NIST met to review and discuss comments
- August 5, 2019 – Final draft distributed to EAC Executive Director and NIST Voting Program Manager
