The EAC has reviewed Engineering Change Order (ECO) 01583, including supporting documentation and analysis provided by the voting system test lab. The ECO impacts the Verity 2.3, 2.3.3, 2.3.4, 2.4, 2.5, 2.6, and 2.7 systems. This minor change to the printer's firmware and internal mechanical feature, improving the print speed of the Touch Writer Duo, does not alter the system's reliability, functionality, capability, or operation. Based on the information provided, it has been determined that no further testing is necessary.
