This minor change updates the Verity Vanguard Manual Application Hash Validation Process Document (Vanguard Manual Application Hash Validation 1000828 A01.) This update to the workstation manual hash process changes the PowerShell Commands that will produce a hash output format result that will be easier for election administrators to compare to the EAC's national repository's trusted hash value output. This change does not alter the system's reliability, functionality, capability, or operation. Based on the information provided, it has been determined that no further testing is necessary.
