Dear Russ Dawson

The EAC has reviewed Engineering Change Order **ECO-CV25-6 ClearMark ATA Case**, including supporting documentation and analysis provided by the voting system test lab. This minor change removes the Ballot Verification Scanner access door from the ATA Case used with the ClearMark ballot marking device and replaces the associated side wall with a solid side wall and an internal shelf. During the ClearVote 2.5 test campaign, the Ballot Verification Scanner was removed, but the access door remained. Closing that unused opening increases security by limiting access. This minor change does not alter the system's reliability, functionality, capability, or operation. Based on the information provided, it has been determined that no further testing is necessary.
