


**Your voting location is

POLL WORKER EDITION




Tensions are escalating as a voter is upset about a provisional ballot. The voter is getting louder and talking over you as you try to explain the process.






**An election observer is

POLL WORKER EDITION




You pick up supplies and ballots on Election Eve and leave them locked in your car. When you head out on election morning, you discover your car has been mistakenly repossessed.




**A fire alarm goes off,

POLL WORKER EDITION




A semi-truck loaded with




It is Election Day, and your area is hit with an unexpected heat wave. Rolling power outages disrupt voting and cause lines. A waiting voter passes out.

POLL WORKER EDITION




Despite being urged not to have beverages at their station, another poll worker has spilled coffee on un-issued ballots.


