



Election Incident Response Contacts at U.S. Federal Agencies

This is a partial list of U.S. federal agencies that election officials can contact to report incidents. If you are in imminent danger or risk of harm, call 911 or contact local law enforcement immediately.

Election officials are encouraged to share information with each other, state fusion centers, local law enforcement, and federal partners. Voluntarily sharing incident information with these partners enables further analysis and helps others evaluate and protect their people, systems, and assets from similar threats and risks. Establishing relationships with partners before an election can facilitate effective communication in the event of an incident.
