The EAC has reviewed Engineering Change Order **HRT-01781**, including supporting documentation and analysis provided by the voting system test lab. This minor change replaces the 8GB vDrive component used in all versions of the Verity Voting system with a 16GB version due to End-of-Life (EOL) of the original system component. It does not alter the system's reliability, functionality, capability, or operation. Based on the information provided, it has been determined that no further testing is necessary.
