This correspondence is to inform you that Revision 3.0 of the test report submitted by Pro V&V for the testing of the Tenex Software Solutions Precinct Central Touchpad v6.1.3 electronic poll book has been reviewed and approved by the U.S. Election Assistance Commission (EAC). A test report is evaluated against criteria as specified in Section 5.8 and Appendix C of the EAC's Election Supporting Technology Evaluation Program Manual (ESTEP Manual) and approved based on the information submitted. The EAC will determine whether testing is sufficient based on the test plan, test case artifacts, and test report.

As provided in Section 6.4 of the ESTEP Manual, for the Tenex Software Solutions Precinct Central Touchpad v6.1.3 electronic poll book to be issued a certification number and a Certificate of Conformance requires manufacturer to submit a letter, signed by both its management representative and a Pro V&V official, identifying that all system documentation has been provided to the EAC, and accepting the certification and all conditions placed on the certification.

Upon demonstrating the successful completion of the requirements above and the recommendation of the Program Director, the Decision Authority must issue a final decision granting certification and providing Tenex Software Solutions with a certification number and Certificate of Conformance for Precinct Central Touchpad v6.1.3.
