The U.S. Election Assistance Commission (EAC) has reviewed Engineering Change Order (ECO) **HRT-01764**, including the supporting documentation and analysis provided by the Voting System Test Laboratory (VSTL). This ECO involves a minor change resulting from the end-of-life status of the thermal paper and paper stock used for VotePass tickets (Vanguard Boost and Vanguard Flex) and Printed Vote Records (PVR) ballots (Verity Duo and Vanguard Flex). Based on the information provided, this change does not alter the system's reliability, functionality, capability, or operation. Accordingly, the EAC has determined that no further testing is necessary.
