Dell Latitude 5350 is the next model to replace the previous models. Latitude 5350 passed the executed end-to-end test case.

Engineering Recommendation:

Based on successful technical documentation review, Pro V&V determines the submitted modification does not adversely impact the functionality, performance, accessibility, usability, safety, or security of the components or system or alter the overall configuration of the certified system. Replacement component is comparable in form, fit, and function to current model. No change to firmware/software is required. Per MicroVote, the operating system and settings remain unchanged from other certified laptops, there is no impact on election officials, and there is no change to system documentation. MicroVote has successfully conducted full end-to-end testing on the laptop model and has confirmed EMS V4.41 system compatibility.
