An expenditure of \$84, 579.73 was made to enable one Alabama county, Jefferson County, to acquire Election Report Management computers, laptops, PCs and other IT related gear for election ad ministration. An expenditure of \$29,925.00 was made to enable one Alabama county, Montgomery County, to acquire electronic ballot marking machines for handicap voters. The difference in the total federal expenditures in the Expenditure Table for question 14 and what was reported on the FFR is \$17,603. The reason it is not included in que stion 14 is because the money was received by the county and immediately returned to the Secretary of State's office without anything being purchased. The disbursement of the funds and the return of the funds were reflected in income (10.1) and expended (10.n) money on the FFR.
