

Report to EAC (continued from FSR): Amended: Title II, 251 FedFY 2005 by South Dakota

12. Remarks to line 10c: Earned \$47,901.70 interest on requirements payments during this reporting period; which is also total interest earned to date. Total appropriated for State 5% match = \$610,358.05. Of this amount, \$198,405.80 was appropriated by the State legislature and spent on the statewide electronic voter file. South Dakota counties fulfilled the remainder of the 5% match requirement by setting aside \$411,952.20 in individual county-held accounts reserved for Title III expenses. Use of these reserved funds are required to be reported to the State. The State did not require counties to put their 5% match reserved balances into interest bearing accounts. During FedFY05, 19 counties spent a total of \$63,897.61 from their county-held accounts. Balance of these accounts ended the year at \$348,054.59. Total State maintenance of effort (MOE) spent during State fiscal year 2005 was \$67,446 and in State fiscal year 2006 was \$68,776.

(1) IN GENERAL---Except as provided in paragraph (2), a state receiving a requirements payment shall use the payment only to meet the requirements of title III.

Payments to 4 counties in FedFY2005 from State-held account reserved for counties	\$10,421.25	Page 9, under 254(a)(5) - Describe the election fund and the management of that fund , describes that this fund has been established within South Dakota state government's accounting system. The account is managed by the Secretary of State. Page 9, under 254(a)(6) - Budget , describes the budgeting of Title II money in the amount of \$5,000,000 for the purchase of the voting machines necessary to comply with SEC. 301 of HAVA. Page 9, under 254(a)(6) - Budget , describes the budgeting of Title II money in the amount of \$3,000,000 reserved for counties to fulfill the requirements of Title III expenses. Because the voting machines purchased by the State for itself and on behalf of South Dakota counties was less than anticipated, the portion of the Title II money in the State-held account reserved for individual counties began with a total balance of \$3,235,652.80. This account earns interest credited to individual counties.
