

Payments were made to Minnehaha County, Edmunds County, Davison County, Hamlin County, and Gregory County to reimburse those counties for expenses relating to the administration of elections for Federal office as allowed under Title III of the Help America Vote Act. These payments were sent to counties only after such counties depleted their county-held accounts, which were established to meet the required match so that the state of South Dakota could receive the federal funds available through this grant program. The South Dakota Secretary of State has created a spreadsheet which divides allowable expenses into 14 categories for South Dakota County Auditors to report to the state. These requests for reimbursements are maintained in a master spreadsheet.

A payment of \$13,368.75 was made to the American Association of Motor Vehicles to facilitate the HAVA-required connection to the Social Security Administration for voter registration checks. Since the South Dakota Driver License Bureau already had an account set up with the American Association of Motor Vehicles, the South Dakota Secretary of State determined that the most cost-effective way to effect the needed connection to the Social Security Administration for the check of records was to augment this existing account.
