Please accept this letter as acknowledgement that ES&S is in receipt of the Notice of Non-Compliance for the EAC certified Unity 3.2.0.0 voting system as detailed in the EAC Formal Investigation Report dated December 20, 2011.

Pursuant to Section 7.6.2 of the EAC *Voting System Testing and Certification Program Manual (Manual)*, it is ES&S' intent to exercise option 7.6.2.3 *Right to Cure System Defects Prior to the Decertification Decision* as allowable by the Program.

Upon your acceptance of this request and pursuant to Sections 7.7.1 *Opportunity to Cure* and 7.7.1.1, Manufacturer's *Request to Cure*, ES&S will be submitting a request for the opportunity to cure the defects identified in the Notice of Non-Compliance and outlined in Section 7.7.1.3 *Manufacturer's Compliance Plan* of the Manual.
