


# Nonprofit spots discrepancy; county elections officials call it human error

### **EAVS** Data in Use








917,694 Election Judges were employed in 2016. Over half (56%) were over the age of 60. 10% of all Election Judges in 2016 were 25 and under.

We have 3,833 active Election Judges as of 2017. Only 5% of our workers are under the age of 25. Following national trends, more than half (58%) are above the age of 60.






# Mode of Voting






### **Provisional Ballots**




- ~1.5 million




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
### **Vote Count Location**
