The purpose of this letter is to certify that the State of Utah will use the funds provided under the Notice of Grant Award, Agreement # UT18101001, for activities consistent with the laws described in Section 906 of HAVA and will not use the funds in a manner that is inconsistent with the requirements of Title III of HAVA.

We further certify that we have reviewed and accept the terms of the award as specified in the Notice of Grant Award. Our UEI number (formerly DUNS) is 094899166 and the signed Certification Regarding Lobbying is enclosed.

We are requesting \$4,111,052 at this time. We will develop the program narrative as follows:

- By July 16, 2018: Request feedback from counties regarding proposed use and allocation of funds and submit detailed program narrative and budget.
- In order to obtain allocated funds, counties will seek reimbursement from the Lieutenant Governor's Office.
- Priorities for use of funds include:
 - Purchase of new voting equipment.
 - Upgrade the state's voter registration database, VISTA.
 - Implement additional digital security measures and security training for both the counties and the state.
