The Election Assistance Commission has reviewed Engineering Change Order (ECO) 100921, including supporting documentation and analysis provided by the voting system test lab, Pro V&V. This addition to the hardware of the ImageCast Voter Activation (ICVA) client workstation does not alter the system's reliability, functionality, capability, or operation. The addition of the Dell Latitude 3340 laptop computer was due to the Dell, Latitude 3420 and 3330 series computers becoming commercially unavailable for purchase. This ECO would affect the following EAC certified systems: Dominion Democracy Suite 5.5, 5.5-A, 5.5-B, 5.5-C, 5.5-D, and 5.17. Based on the information provided, it has been determined that no further testing is necessary.

This correspondence is to inform you that Dominion ECO 100921 is approved.
