The State of Alaska, Division of Elections (division) is pleased to submit this narrative report to document Alaska's use of Help America Vote Act (HAVA) Title I, Section 101 Election Security funds during the above mentioned reporting period. The State of Alaska's expenditures remain consistent with the activities described in the 2018 HAVA Program and Budget Narrative submitted to the Election Assistance Commission after receipt of the Election Security Funds. Specifically, Title I funds were used to carry out the following activities during the above mentioned reporting period:

VOTING EQUIPMENT REPLACEMENT: \$22,086.05 (PRINCIPAL)

To meet the goal established in the program narrative of replacing an aging voting system, the Division issued a Request for Proposal (RFP) to solicit vendors capable of providing a new voting tabulation system for the State of Alaska. In order to properly prepare for a project of this magnitude the Division contracted with an outside firm to assist in creating a high-level project plan for the RFP. During the review process, the review committee convened in Juneau and Anchorage for negotiations and the funds were used to pay for travel. A contract was awarded to Dominion Voting Systems and the division immediately began working toward implementation for the 2020 election.

The contract with Dominion is for a precinct-based voting system as well as ballot marking devices to provide accessible voting for individuals with disabilities, including non-visual accessibility for the blind and visually impaired and those needing language assistance. The next fiscal cycle will bring exciting changes as the new system is deployed and the older system is retired.

The associated SF425 report for this reporting period is enclosed. Interest accrued on both federal and state match funds during this reporting period was \$147,068.28.

Thank you for the opportunity to provide this information on the work the State of Alaska has done and continues to do in order to meet the requirements of HAVA. Please let me know if you require any additional information.
