ELECTION SECURITY FUNDS

In April 2018, Congress appropriated from the Omnibus Appropriations Act of 2018, election security funds. Florida specifically was allocated \$19,187,003. The funds were used as follows:

- \$15,450,000 These funds were distributed through an online grant program for 67 county supervisors of elections to request advance funds and/or reimbursement for enhancements to election security at the county level for the 2018 election cycle. Each county was allocated an amount that included a baseline of \$50,000 plus an additional amount proportional to the county's voting age population as of the 2010 census. Each county was required to submit a proposed budget plan up to the allocated amount for the county. All 67 counties initially applied for and received funding for reimbursement and/or advancement to spend by November 6, 2018. The deadline for counties to report expenditures and revert any unused funds was December 15, 2018. The Department re-allocated the remaining balance of the unused funds back to the supervisors of elections to use prior to the end of the state fiscal year. In sum, counties requested and used \$15,133,941 of the original \$15,450,000 available for disbursement.
- \$1,750,000 These funds were earmarked by the Florida Department of State to implement security enhancements to FVRS, contract a team of cybersecurity specialists to provide support to the state and county supervisor of elections offices, and to fund a voter education campaign to educate voters on how to get ready to register and vote in an election. As of 9/30/2019, all funds have been expended.
- \$1,987,003 These funds were originally earmarked for an online grant program to the 67 county supervisors of elections to improve on voting accessibility including but not limited to improving voting place accessibility, enhancing poll book accessibility, ballot delivery, and voting systems accessibility. These funds were not disbursed but are now re-appropriated for disbursement for the 2020 election cycle in conjunction to enhance election security in the counties.

The state match of \$959,350.15 has not yet been reported but will be by March 23, 2020.
