As a result of an RFP issued in the Fall of 2021, Maine selected a vendor and executed a contract in April of 2022, encumbered with Election Security funds, for the custom development and implementation of a Central Voter Registration and Election Management Solution to replace its current system. Other expenditures in support of this effort included obtaining contracts with an independent Project Manager to oversee the CVR project and a Technical Consultant to assist the Department with determining hardware, software and security needs for the new system as well as assisting with User Acceptance Testing and helping us to keep the existing CVR system running until the new system can be deployed. We implemented Automatic Voter Registration in the existing CVR system in accordance with State law. We also used funds to support accessible voting by paying the annual cost of a software service to provide accessible electronic absente ballots. Finally, to improve the security of the data in the current CVR system, we conducted a statewide NVRA list maintenance mailing in 2022. These activities were planned and documented in the 2022 Combined HAVA Election Security Grant Funds Budget and Narrative.
