Bureau of Elections announced the availability of up to \$8 million in HAVA security grant funding for local election officials. The grant program reimburses locals for specified expenses to improve physical security of election locations, purchases to upgrade technology and networks used to support election administration and procuring services to help secure elections. Grant reimbursement requests were received from 455 local jurisdictions totaling \$3,083,047.81 for costs that were incurred by September 30, 2022. Of this amount, \$87,117.92 was paid for with state match.
