For the period of October 2021 to March 2022 the Virginia Department of Elections (ELECT) has continued to move forward with the development of a new statewide voter registration system. ELECT is currently evaluating response. The new system will replace the state's current voter registration system with a system that is in a newer programming language that will allow for a more secure and flexible system. ELECT received several qualifying bids from the RFP process. Its anticipated that an award

will be made by the end of the calendar year. State funding has been approved based on the estimated cost of the new system that would insure ELECT will exceed any match requirements. ELECT continue to use lessons learned from Risk Limiting Audit's to adjust its approach to the audits in the development of it's tool kit that can be used by all cities and counties in the commonwealth for elections.

In addition to the major development of a statewide voter registration system, ELECT continued to implement other security improvements during the period:

- Information Security Governance Program enhancements
- Create, review and modify plans, policies, and procedures
- Continual Risk Remediation
- Ongoing effort based on emerging risks
- Institute Data Privacy Program
- Locality Security Support
- Support to locality Election and IT offices enhancing security
- Creation of Virginia Cyber Navigator Program
