Other disbursements were for homebound voting services and off-island absentee voting. Voter Registration Systems Funds were used to imp rove Guan's online voter registration and motor voter registration processes, specifically in communicating with new registrats after voter registration applications are proc essed and purchasing supplies necessary to make the processing of motor voter registration more efficient.
