# Voting Equipment

The budgeted amount set aside for Voting Equipment is \$100,000. At the end of FY2018, no expenditures were made. Details for the use of the budgeted funds are still being considered.

## **Election Auditing**

**Budgeted Amounts:** 

- 1. Training \$200,000
- 2. Other \$338,505

As of the end of the FY2018 no expenditures have been made.

## Voter Registration Systems

**Budgeted Amounts:** 

- 1. Personnel \$150,000
- 2. Training \$250,000
- 3. Other \$1,000,000

No Personnel funds have been expended. We are currently seeking a project manager to oversee the implementations of the various projects under this budget. All funds budgeted were remaining at years' end.

No Training funds have been expended. Training will begin prior to the release of the new software system. All funds budgeted were remaining at years' end.

'Other' funds expended were \$496,666.67, \$14,375.51 of which was paid for with the interest earned in FY18. The Secretary of State's office entered into a contract with Tenex on August 24, 2018 in response to the RFP mentioned in our original plan regarding our Voter Registration System upgrade. The funds expended were our initial payment to Tenex. Remaining funds budgeted at years' end were \$517,708.84.

#### **Cyber Security**

## **Budgeted Amounts:**

- 1. Personnel \$220,000
- 2. Training \$250,000
- 3. Other \$111,391

No Personnel funds have been expended. Our intent is still to hire a Cybersecurity Policy Analyst with full time benefits this coming fiscal year. All funds budgeted were remaining at years' end.

No training funds have been expended for FY18. Funds are set aside for an annual statewide TTX training in January of 2019 which is offered to all county clerks and associated Elections staff. All funds budgeted were remaining at years' end.

'Other' costs expended were \$900 to PDQ.com. These funds were used for a software license for deploying security patches across the network. Remaining funds at year end were \$110,491.

#### **Communications**

#### **Budgeted Amounts:**

- 1. Personnel \$200,000
- 2. Other \$110,000

Personnel funds expended in FY2018 were \$13,697.43. A Communications Coordinator was hired in July with full-time benefits. Remaining funds at year end were \$186,302.57.

'Other' funds expended in FY2018 were \$1800 to LeapFox Learning. These funds were used by our IT department to set up a secure online Sharepoint used for document management. Funds remaining at years' end were \$108,200.

#### Other

The budgeted amount for any other expenditures is \$150,000. These funds are reserved to address existing software updates that require immediate attention to extend the viability long enough to allow the development and deployment of the new system. No funds were expended at year end.

Total funds expended in Fiscal year 2018 were \$513,064.10. Expenditures were broken down to \$498,688.59 from federal funds and \$14,375.51 from interest earned. Our match money was not included in any FY18 funds as we will not receive those funds until July of 2019.
