# MISSOURI SECRETARY OF STATE REPORT ON EXPENDITURE OF TITLE 1, SEC. 101 – 2018 ELECTION SECURITY OCTOBER 2018 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 2019

#### Title 1, Sec. 101 - 2018 Election Security - \$556,746.30

The funds in this section were used only to meet the requirements of Title 1 – 2018 Election Security grant.

#### Please note:

- \$74,139.76 was expended between October 1, 2018 and September 30, 2019
  - Cyber Security Services \$62,850.00

During the reporting period, Missouri continued its cybersecurity enhancements to thwart attempts to corrupt the Missouri Centralized Voter Registration (MCVR) system. These services include assessments of the local election authorities.

#### Cyber Security Training and Travel - \$11,289.76

This includes cost associated with the September 2018 National Elections security Summit (NESS) that Missouri hosted. Federal, state, and local election authorities were in attendance to discuss useable steps to mitigate threats and vulnerabilities.

In addition, the Missouri Secretary of State purchased a service to conduct training and educate elections staff and local election authorities on cybersecurity security awareness.

#### \$482,606.54 was encumbered as of October 31, 2019

 This includes encumbered funds for services to conduct assessments of the local election authorities.
