HAVA Narrative for 2018 HAVA Security Grant October 2018-September 30, 2019:

<u>ADA: \$5,047.99</u> Supplies (traffic cones, improved signage) to make Polling Locations more accessible were acquired be several counties.

<u>Cyber Security:</u> \$92,057.83 FTE employee on loan from NJ Homeland Security to assist Division of Elections with cyber security protection and planning.

<u>VVPAT Pilot:</u> \$200,642.68 Gloucester, Hunterdon and Union counties each conducted a Voter Verified Paper Trail pilot using HAVA funds to either purchase or rent new voting machines to access usability and public acceptance.

<u>Training:</u> \$14,180.52 Training sessions were held for county election officials to discuss security issues involving elections and Division Management attended several national conferences. Part of the expense for the statewide TTX was also charged during this period with the remainder charged in the current fiscal year.

SRVS Security: \$62,164.95 Seven counties used HAVA funds to clean up their district maps and street files to improve the accuracy of address data as we implement a geo-coding system in the modernized SVRS.
