Cybersecurity Monitoring:

During federal fiscal year 2021, the Ohio Secretary of State's Office supported local election officials and cybersecurity efforts by funding Albert intrusion detection devices and monitoring services from SIEM for all 88 county boards of elections.

Local entity cybersecurity assistance:

The Office also provided cybersecurity security support to local partners by contracting with experts who provide IT support to county boards of elections, including assistance with tool, software or hardware integration; software and patch management support; network analysis review; incident response planning and exercising; tier one incident management forensic collection support; and general engineering technical assistance.

Subgrants to local entities:

The Office has also continued to assist and support county boards of elections in the implementation of cybersecurity and physical security enhancements funded through sub-grants which were previously distributed to each county board of elections in federal fiscal year 2020.
