## OREGON SECRETARY OF STATE REPORT ON EXPENDITURE OF TITLE I, SECTION 101 ELECTION SECURITY GRANT FUNDS OCTOBER 2018 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 2019

As requested by the U.S Election Assistance Commission, please find listed below a detailed list of expenditures and a description of the related activities conducted by the Oregon Secretary of State utilizing Help America Vote Act (HAVA) Title I, Section 101 Election Security Grant Funds during the period from October 1, 2018 through September 30, 2019.

## **Cybersecurity - \$353,336.47**

HAVA funds were used for cybersecurity by hiring two full time employees to add to our security team. We also used the funds to bring in outside consultants to assess our systems.

## Voter Registration Systems - \$153,617.61

HAVA funds were used to add some resiliency to our voter registration system for the 2020 election cycle. Greater resiliency and redundancy will be integrated for the 2022 election cycle and beyond given that there was not enough time to go through the procurement process, finalize a contract and implement a solution before March 1, 2020.
