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2018-2019 Election Security Funds Program Narrative

Below is a narrative detailing expenditures made by Tennessee using the election security funds provided by the Consolidated Appropriations Act of 2018 between October 1, 2018, and September 30, 2019, as well as a summary of ongoing activities using the funds.

Cyber Vulnerabilities & Training

The Division of Elections engaged with a leading cybersecurity vendor to offer on-site scans to 90 county election commission offices prior to the November 2018 general election, as well as assistance to counties to make improvements identified by these scans.

The vendor presented at our statewide training seminar for election officials in June 2019. They discussed cybersecurity best practices and conducted a live hacking demonstration to show how a phishing email can lead to a system compromise. A total of \$39,669.38 was paid to the vendor using the election security funds in this fiscal year.

We also contracted with a company that offers online security training to provide monthly lessons for administrators of elections, staff, and county election commissioners at a cost of \$5,964.00.

Voting Equipment Replacement and Upgrades

The Division of Elections hosted a vendor fair in January 2019 to allow all vendors to present their systems with a voter verified paper record to legislators and county election officials at a cost of \$3,079.14.

The Division of Elections made grants available using the new funds to county election commissions beginning in the spring 2019. One (1) county purchased a new voting system between the opening of the grant period and the end of the fiscal year.

Seven (7) counties (Greene, Houston, Loudon, Knox, McMinn, White, and Williamson) have purchased or are in the process of purchasing systems with a voter verified paper record that are eligible for grants using the election security funds.

Voting Registration Systems and Management

The Division of Elections has also made grants available for upgraded computers to interface with the statewide voter registration database maintained by the Division of Elections. These grants will cost approximately \$180,000 and will be paid out in this fiscal year.

Summary

The chart below summarizes the expenses by category. Looking ahead, we will also be making a \$25,000 grant available to each county to assist with security needs. Along with the computer grants and additional voting system grants, we anticipate Tennessee will have used all of our election security funding by the end of 2020.
