Dear Ms. Harrington:

The purpose of this letter is to certify that the Commonwealth of Kentucky will use the funds provided under the Notice of Grant Award, Agreement # KY20101CARES, for activities consistent with the laws described in Section 906 of HAVA and will not use the funds in a manner that is inconsistent with the requirements of Title III of HAVA.

We further certify that we have reviewed and accept the terms of the award as specified in the Notice of Grant Award. Our UEI number (formerly DUNS) is 157363644 and the signed Certifications are enclosed.

We request \$6,090,061.00. We will use the funds to prevent, prepare for, and respond to coronavirus, domestically or internationally, for the 2020 Federal election cycle. To address the effects of the coronavirus on the election we anticipate the need for additional supplies related to absentee voting, increased postage costs, the need to purchase additional equipment for scan of absentee ballots, increased personnel cost, additional costs of sanitizing supplies and more. The Commonwealth of Kentucky, through action of the Governor, upon recommendation of the Secretary of State, postponed their primary election 35 days as an initial reaction to the pandemic. The Secretary of State and State Board of Elections are currently assessing additional steps that could be taken.
