The purpose of this letter is to certify that the State of Maine will use the funds providedt under the Notice of Grant Award, Agreement # ME20101CARES for activities consistent withtthe laws described in Section 906 of HAVA and will not use the funds in a manner thattis inconsistent withthe requirements of Title III of HAVA.

Wetfurther certify that we have reviewed and accept thetterms of the awardtas specified in the Notice of Grant Award.tOur UEI number (formerly DUNS)tist184574648 and the signed Certifications are tenclosed.

Wetare requesting \$3,299,827. We will use the funds to prevent, prepare for,tand respond totcoronavirus, domestically or internationally, for the 2020 Federal election cycle. To address the effects of the coronavirus on the election we plan to use funds to defray the State's costs of printing and distribution of additional absentee ballots and mailing envelopes to the municipalities in anticipation of a significant increase in the use of absentee voting for the 2020 primarytand general elections. If practicable, we may pay for return postage for absentee ballots. Wetalsotmay centrally lease additional precinct tabulation devices to providettotmunicipalities that may experience a higher number of absentee ballots to be processed and scanned prior to election day, as welltas ballot drop boxes to facilitate no contact return of absentee ballots.

Additionally, to protect poll workers and voters at election day voting sites, we anticipate centrally procuring and supplying to municipalities PPEs such astvisors, gloves and masks, as well as hand sanitizer and disinfectant wipes and/or plexiglass and other spacing barriers for social distancing. We may also reimburse municipalities for costs related to securing a new voting place due tottheir existing place(s) beingtunavailable or insufficient totadhere to social distancing requirements as well as to help pay for extra or replacement poll workers.t
