DotGov Migration Support

The Secretary of State is encouraging municipal and county governments to move their election websites to the DotGov (.gov) domain. Currently, a small percentage of jurisdictions in Michigan use this domain. Although the domain is now free, jurisdictions have direct and indirect costs associated with moving their current website domain to DotGov. This includes, among other things, secure site hosting costs and staffing and contracting costs associated with establishment and maintenance of the website under the new domain. The Secretary will make support available through reimbursement and consultation.

Election Day Equipment Upgrades

The Secretary of State will provide support for municipal and county officials in updating equipment used on election day to enhance security and reduce the potential for performance-related failures that could cause voter delays. Election Day equipment eligible for upgrades will include electronic pollbook laptops; encrypted drives; and improvements to delivery of election night results from polling place tabulators to the municipal and/or county clerk for unofficial reporting. The Secretary of State expects to supplement this funding from unused funding for the 2020 HAVA Grant, including funding allocated to local election security equipment support and election night reporting upgrades.
